What is the REVEL?

The Historic Camden Inaugural Revel is an event celebrating Camden's extraordinary Colonial and Revolutionary War history with a modern flair. Inspired by lively backcountry parties of the times, the Revel will delight attendees with food, drinks, an art auction, games and live entertainment in a relaxed atmosphere.

When and where is the REVEL?

The reconstructed Kershaw-Cornwallis House & Gardens sits on 107 acres atop the original 18th-century property of the City of Camden founder Joseph Kershaw and the fortified Revolutionary War era town occupied by British General Cornwallis and Lord Rawdon's men from 1780-81.

Visitors to the site learn about the prolific Joseph Kershaw, Camden's importance to the war's Southern Campaigns, and Colonial life in the backcountry. In addition to the Kershaw-Cornwallis House, visit the recently rehabilitated c.1800 McCaa's Tavern as well as exhibits in other period structures. What is included with my ticket?

Can I buy tickets at the door?

REVEL Tickets are offered on a first-come, first served basis and can be purchased on the Historic Camden website or in the Historic Camden Gift Shop during regular business hours. We do have limited capacity for the Revel, so we advise purchasing tickets at your earliest convenience to take advantage of early bird pricing of \$75 each through March 3, 2019. Tickets will be sold for \$85 each after March 3rd and will be available at the door if not sold out. Tickets are non-refundable.

What happens in the event of inclement weather?

The REVEL will be held rain or moonshine. Since the event will be held inside the Kershaw-Cornwallis House as well as in the gardens and outdoor tented space, wear dressy casual attire for the temperature with comfortable shoes appropriate for walking on unpaved surfaces.

What about parking?

There will be plenty of free parking on site adjacent to the Kershaw-Cornwallis House. Drivers will be able to drop guests off in front of the house before parking.
